You must have a hole dug before the actual planting if you are not paying to plant. Size is about 2 to 3 feet in diameter, 2 feet deep in a cylindrical or half spherical shape for a 2 to 2 ½ caliper trunk. If you need assistance, holes can be dug and the tree planted for \$50 with prior notification and planning. Notification emails will be sent to provide a dig time and planting dates.
